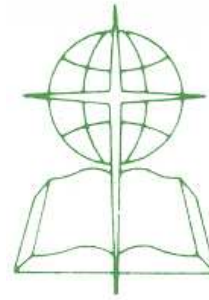

I want to thank each individual and each church who has responded to the Haiti relief either by giving financially or by purchasing *Buckets of Hope*. Thanks to your generosity, the associational office has already forwarded \$2,700.00 toward medical missions. We still have \$9,336.00 to go toward other mission efforts in Haiti. Our Disaster Relief Director will continue to stay in close contact with SBC entities in an effort to determine when and how the association can appropriately respond next.

With regards to the *Buckets of Hope*, our office has distributed 276 buckets as of this writing. Churches should in turn fill the buckets with the recommended food items and return them to the associational office by March 10. If your church has 10 or more buckets, please contact the office for a scheduled pick-up. Before the buckets are shipped to Haiti, a label will be affixed to the container. The label will have the gospel presentation and a note indicating that the *Bucket of Hope* is a gift from Southern Baptist.

I also want to thank all of the individuals and churches who gave to the Pregnancy Crisis Center's Diaper Drive. Your excellence in giving set a new record of over \$12,000.00. Your giving has welled-up in many expressions of thanks to God by the center's director, Lanette Breeden, and all of the volunteers.
