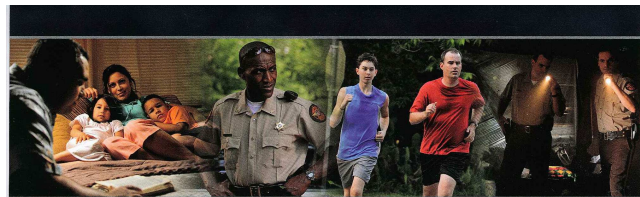
**Week of Prayer for the Golden Offering and Tennessee Missions**
